Course Outline - TM1 Advanced Developer (2 Day Course)

This two-day course expands on the foundation skills introduced in the Excelerated Consulting Developer Course. Attendees will extend their skills to cover TM1 rules, TurboIntegrator (TI) processes and Action Buttons. These functions will then be integrated through examples of practical application in a hands-on environment.

Who should attend:

This course is an advanced TM1 course and would be of benefit to aspiring and existing TM1 Administrators and Developers. The course will cover sufficient skills for students to create basic TM1 rules, TI processes and Action Buttons to enhance existing TM1 databases. Participants should have a sound knowledge of TM1 and be familiar with spreadsheet programs (Microsoft Excel is used in this course) and the Microsoft Windows operating system.

Developer training is a pre-requisite for this course.
